

MIGRANTS REGISTRATION

The Federal Government of Nigeria has commenced the electronic registration of all migrants and foreigners residing and those who wish to reside in Lagos beyond 90 days. This includes house helps, drivers, security guards, commercial motorcycle riders etc.

All landlords and employers of such migrants have a duty under the Immigration law to ensure that they are duly registered.

This scheme is to enable Government have an accurate data on migrants as this will go a long way in encouraging brotherliness as well as enhancing the security of this great nation.

Registration is on-going at the Nigerian Immigration Service, Lagos State Command Office at Alagbon Close, Ikoyi Lagos and the Zonal Office at PWD, Ikeja Lagos. They are to come with valid means of identification and letters of introduction from their sponsors or employer.

Pls note: migrants who come forward for registration will not be arrested, punished or deported. This exercise is free.

In line with this development, the Federal Government has granted six months amnesty period that would expire on the 12th of January, 2020 after which the law will take its course.
